

2006-08 GSAC Basketball Schedule Criteria

Athletic Directors' Criteria:

1. Two-year roll over schedule.
 - The 2006-07 schedule is reversed to form the 2007-08 schedule.
2. Not more than two home or away matches in a row.
3. Home & away balance in each round of the schedule in a double round robin schedule.
 - 2 teams have a 5-5 balance in each round.
 - 9 teams have 4-6 or 6-4 in each round.
4. Strive for balance on weekend and midweek matches.
 - Periphery teams have byes on weekdays.
 - The following is a list of what occurs for 2006-07 (home and away switch for 2007-08):

5. Extreme distance institutions do not have to travel to extreme distance institutions two consecutive games. (San Diego / Fresno / Santa Barbara)
6. If possible the extreme distance institutions will play each other on a weekend.
 - San Diego teams play Westmont & Fresno Pacific on Saturdays.
 - Westmont plays Fresno Pacific on Tuesdays by design. FPU needs five different Tuesday opponents, and WC is one of the five best options (along with TMC, APU, BU & HIU).
7. Attempt in single round schedules to have the extreme distance teams to travel to the other extreme teams once.

Also of Note:

- In any full calendar week, each team has one home & one away game.
- Teams do not start the 2006-07 season with the same opponent they started with in 2005-06, nor do they finish with the same opponent in 2006-07 as in 2005-06.
